

Trail Description

The map on the other side shows location of the trails. The trails are marked with 3-inch diameter plastic blue, red and yellow markers. They are placed 5 to 7 feet above the ground and generally on the right side of the trail. Double markers signify that the trail is changing directions.

Rules

- Enjoy the Glen from dawn to dusk.
- Dogs must be on a leash.
- Pick up after your dog.
- No motorized vehicles
- No fires and no camping.
- No littering or dumping.
- Leave plants, vegetation, rocks, and animals undisturbed.
- No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.
- No hunting or weapons allowed.
- No rock climbing or rappelling

Directions to The Glen

The Glen is in Endwell in the Town of Union about six miles west of Binghamton, New York and a little over a mile east of Endicott, New York.

From Hooper Road in Endwell, NY go east on Country Club Road. After top of the hill turn left on Robinson Hill Road. Go 1.2 miles. Parking lot, when constructed, will be on the right. Look for Waterman Sign and yellow trail markers.

Coming from Oakdale Mall, go west on Harry L Drive which becomes Watson Boulevard . Turn right on Country Club Road. Near the top of the hill turn right on Robinson Hill Road. Follow above directions.

The Fred L. Waterman Conservation Education Center is a private, non-profit community nature center that provides environmental education and outdoor recreational opportunities for people of all ages and interests.

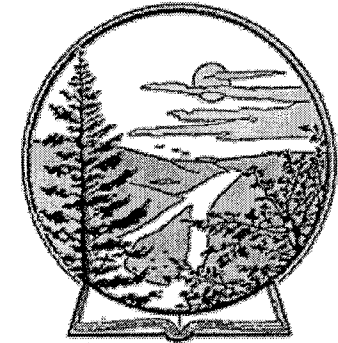

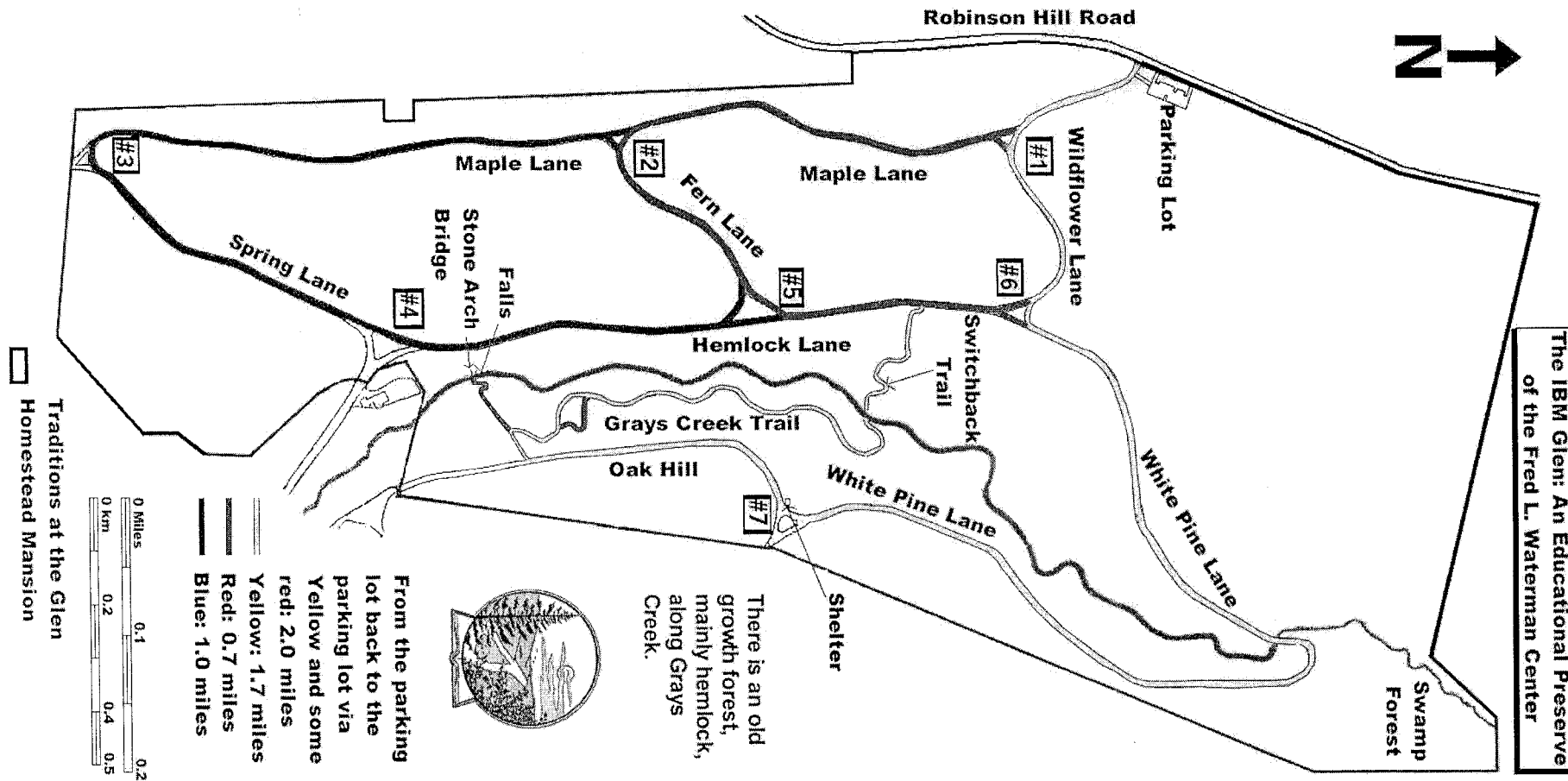
